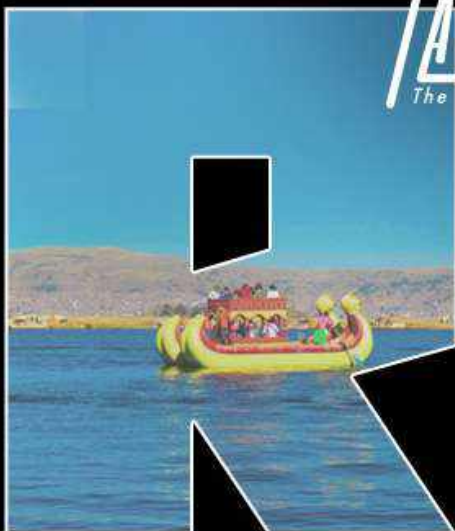

CITY TOUR

In this excursion, we will take a trip back in time to explore the beautiful city walls, palaces and Incan temples, as well as the colonial architecture Cusco has to offer. We will have a professional guide to tell us about the city. We'll begin at the temple of Qorikancha, the place where the Incas used to worship the Sun God and where a monastery was also built. Then we will visit the delightful Plaza de Armas and its cathedral. The Sacsayhuaman fortress, famous for its perfectly shaped rocks and its magical history will be our next stop. To finish the tour, we will walk to some more important archeological sites situated on the outskirts of the city: Qenqo, Puca Pucara and Tambomachay.

SACRED VALLEY

In this trip we will have the chance to visit one of the worlds most beautiful valleys, admiring the magic of the Incan Empire and its unique relationship with nature. We will begin by visiting Písaq, well known for its artesan market full of colours and traditions and also for its ruins, a feat of ancient architecture. At midday we will have lunch in Urubamba, the central city of the valley. The next stop is Ollantaytambo, a town that is almost completely preserved and will take us back several centuries through its incredible ruins. Returning to Cusco we will stop at the town of Chinchero, particularly interesting for its famous artesan textile fair.

SOUTH VALLEY

In this route towards the picturesque Southern Valley, 30 km from Cusco, we will see 3 important sites in the region. The first is Tipon, a water station that remains in perfect functioning condition, here we will learn about the Incan cult of worshipping the water element. It is a surprising work of hydraulic engineering. Our next destination will be Pikillaqta, a city of pre-Incan Wari architecture, here we see traces of urbanisation from the period. Our last stop will be Andahuaylillas, a traditional town that we will explore, heading towards the famous 'American Sistine Chapel', famous of its conservation of art from the 'cuzqueña' school.

MARAS & MORAY

On this trip we head to the Sacred Valley of the Incas to explore two unmissable sites. During the trip we will survey beautiful snow peaks and unforgettable landscapes. The first stop will be Moray whose archeological remains take the form of an amphitheatre and were the agricultural hub of the Incan empire. Our next attraction will be the Salineras at Maras, incredible salt mines made in more than 3000 wells. A world class landscape that you shouldn't miss.

RAINBOW MOUNTAIN

An adventure awaits us across a natural and wild terrain. This visit combines panoramic views of towering mountains, snowy peaks, Andean skies, scenes of grazing alpacas and more. The pickup will be very early, consisting of a trip by bus to our first stop, where a local breakfast will be served. From there we will be starting our 3 hours hike to Rainbow Mountain. It is one of the most impressive geological formations of the Andes Mountain range. Its exposed minerals form a colorful surreal image which is difficult to find anywhere else. Later on, a replenishing lunch will be waiting for us before we make our way back.

RED VALLEY EXPERIENCE: for a more distinctive, in depth experience with less people influx, we have the option of visiting the Red Valley. We will descend into the valley following the river and observing new and inspiring landscapes.

Come and discover this lake at the feet of snowy Humantay Mountain, in an excursion that boasts beautiful landscapes from start to finish. We will begin our adventure with a trip to Mollepata, a charming town where breakfast is waiting for us. Then we will head to Soraypampa, the beginning of one and a half hour hike upslope. During the trip we will be greeted by majestic mountains, as we reach the lake. There will be time to take in its beauty, and capture the moment. On the way back we will have lunch and finally return to Cusco.

We will then head to the Salineras at Maras, a beautiful place where we will learn how salt is produced in 3000 white wells. During this tour we will also have the chance to appreciate the snowy peaks of Veronica and Chicon.

VIA FERRATA AND/OR ZIPLINE

Don't let the opportunity to do an all inclusive outdoor activity in one of the most incredible places in the Sacred Valley slip by! Situated between Urubamba and Ollantaytambo, we find a stone wall and mountains that beckon to be explored from above. An adventure that does not require any previous experience and has all the necessary safety measures, apart from a fully qualified staff, guarantees an unforgettable adventure. What is a via ferrata? It is a route on iron stairs on the wall of a mountain which has a safety system permanently installed. A unique way to move through spectacular mountainous scenery. What is zipline or canopy? It's to travel suspended on a pulley along a steel cable on a determined slope. Dare to climb a mountain (Via Ferrata), and soar through the magical Sacred Valley (Zipline) or a combination of the 2 adventures (Via Ferrata & Zipline). 200% recommended.

HORSEBACK RIDING X ZONE

Found in the highlands of Cusco, this relaxing excursion gives you the opportunity to visit untouched archeological and natural sites. We will leave the hostel and head towards the Temple of the Moon, a place that was of great importance to the Incas and whose mystical and mysterious energies are guaranteed to delight. We will then continue our ride through Zone X, a place with very unique countryside and views. Our last stop will be 'The Devil's Balcony', one of the favourite walking spots of Cusco's habitants. In each place mentioned, we will stop to listen to our guide's stories about the surroundings. We will then return to the hostel.

BIKING MARAS & MORAY

This bicycle tour is both sport and adventure, and will give you the chance to really appreciate the charming countryside around the Maras and Moray area. In Cruzpata we will pick up the cycling kit and will receive an induction briefing from the guide. We will head to the agricultural terraces in Moray, the Incan agricultural laboratory where we will receive a tour. We will then head down toward the Maras district, passing through local communities, towards the Salineras, to go and explore the famous salt mines and learn about the collection process. Then we will have some free time to charge our batteries with a lunch box before we proceed down towards Urubamba river where we will take our transport back to Cusco.

BUNGEE JUMPING AND/OR SLINGSHOT

This option is full of adrenaline. The bungee jumping station, situated in Poroy, 30 minutes from the city, is considered the highest in South America, at 122 metres. After an induction we will head to the site in private transport. You will experience a mindblowing free-fall, we promise! The Slingshot or Catapult takes you more than 100 metres high at an unimaginable speed. Know that all the equipment used has been specially designed for these activities. Action Valley has a record of 40 000 jump since 1996.

ON THE WAY TO MACHU PICCHU

Reaching Machu Picchu is quite an adventure but... when we start to plan our tour, deciding how to get there can be overwhelming. In summary, there are 3 ways to get to Aguas Calientes, the closest town to the World Wonder, leaving from Cusco: travelling by train (via Poroy or Ollantaytambo), travelling by bus (via Hidroeléctrica), or doing a trek (Inka Trail, Inka Jungle, or Salkantay). Each one of these ways has its own particularities and they differ according to your budget, your time, and what you would like to see. Moreover, it is also important to consider how much time you have: you can go to Machu Picchu for a full day, sleep in Aguas Calientes 1 or 2 nights, or do a trek for several days. This is the first question you should ask yourself before organizing your visit.

IN MACHU PICCHU

Aguas Calientes (2040 m.a.s.l.) is the closest town to the Incan citadel which it is located 20 mins by bus or 1:30 hrs uphill walk. It's a picturesque town with tropical climate all year round, surrounded by green mountains and crossed by the Vilcanota River, also known as Urubamba. You can only get there by train from Ollantaytambo or Hidroeléctrica, or walking the Inka Trail. There are no vehicles and you can walk around the whole town in a matter of minutes. This town lives from tourism and has all the necessary services such as hotels, restaurants, ATMs, markets and places to shop, and offers alternatives for all tastes and budgets. Aguas Calientes has natural attractions such as Putucusi Mountain and the Mandor Gardens.

1. ENTRANCE TO MACHU PICCHU

ADDITIONAL INFO: The entrance ticket is issued by the Ministry of Culture and it is for personal use. Machu Picchu can only receive 6000 visitors a day and Huayna Picchu 400. There are different rates for foreigners, nationals, Andean Community nationals, and students. Students should show their university ID with a validity of no longer than 1 year. If you wish to visit Huayna Picchu or La Montaña (2 different schedules for each one) you have to buy the ticket along with the Machu Picchu entrance ticket. To get into the citadel it is obligatory to show your ID used at the purchase. Re-entry is not allowed. Make your plans to visit ahead of time: change of dates and/or names are not allowed. **Ask What a Trip for rates and further info.**

TIPS: Temperatures in Machu Picchu are high and sunblock is indispensable. It's important to have bug spray and comfortable shoes. During the rainy season wear waterproof clothing. Take a light backpack. Try to be punctual with your entry time to get the most out of your time in the Incan Citadel. If you wish to know more about the World Wonder you can visit the Machu Picchu Museum in Cusco.



2. GUIDE IN MACHU PICCHU

The client is responsible for bringing all the necessary documents in order to perform their trip satisfactorily: passports, visas, certifications, vaccines, etc.

LEGAL AGE

All clients declare being of legal age when asking for a quote. In the case they are not, they must inform WAT.

LOAN OR RENTAL OF COMPLEMENTARY SERVICES

Depending on the tour, equipment or other objects that facilitate the client's experience may be loaned. At the same time, the client can decide to rent complementary equipment (hiking poles, backpacks, sleeping bags, etc). The equipment or objects must be returned in the same conditions in which they were given. In its failure, WAT reserves the right to make charges for reparations.

PAYMENT

RATE CONDITIONS

The final rates may suffer modifications due to availability in spite of a completed payment. These cases are minimal but may occur especially due to a high demand of certain services that WAT has no control over (for example train tickets, entrance tickets, or hotel rates). In this case, we will contact the client as soon as possible before making any payments to the providers of the final service. The service will be confirmed only after receiving a "Confirmation and Reservation Number".

COMMISSIONS FOR PAYMENT

Commissions for choosing to use a certain payment method (commissions for bank transfers, PayPal, etc) will be assumed by the client. WAT must receive the exact payment corresponding to the sent quotation.

ACCEPTANCE OF RATES

The client declares to accept the rate offered by WAT once the payment has been made. Any type of claim after the payment has been made is not entitled to any refund.

RESERVATION

RESERVATION CONFIRMATION

The purchase of a tour is confirmed only when the client receives a "Confirmation and Reservation Number" via e-mail.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

WAT recommends all clients hire travel insurance previous to any trip and in this way preventing any major expenses should, unfortunately, medical attention be required. WAT DOES NOT include travel insurance.

POST SALES CONTACT

Any communication from the client either for changes, cancellations, refund requests or any other matter, must be via e-mail for its validity and within the allotted time frame.

CHANGES

CHANGE OF DATES

Each purchased tour has a particular condition for date modifications (generally with a minimum of 7 days in advance and with a charge of 10% of the paid amount) which can be inquired previous to any purchase. Any expense already made by WAT that does not allow the modification of tour dates will not be refunded and will be assumed by the client independent of date of purchase and type of tour (example: the purchase of train tickets).

CHANGE OF A RESERVED TOUR

Each purchased tour has a particular condition for reserved tour modifications (generally with a minimum of 14 days in advance and with a charge of 10% of the paid amount) which can be inquired previous to any purchase. Any expense already made by WAT that does not allow the modification of tours will

not be refunded and will be assumed by the client independent of date of purchase and type of tour (example: the purchase of train tickets).

CHANGE OF NUMBER OF PEOPLE

The decrease in the number of people is subject to the conditions for cancellations of the service. The increase of the number of people will be subject to a new quote in order to confirm the rate.

TRANSFER OF SERVICE TO ANOTHER PERSON

Each purchased tour has a particular condition for the transfer of services (generally with a minimum of 7 days in advance and with a charge of 10% of the paid amount) which can be inquired previous to any purchase. Any expense already made by WAT that does not allow the transfer of services will not be refunded and will be assumed by the client independent of date of purchase and type of tour (example: the purchase of train tickets).

CANCELLATIONS

AT THE CLIENT'S REQUEST

Each purchased tour has a particular condition for cancellations (generally with a **minimum of 14 days in advance and with a charge of 30% of the paid amount**) which can be inquired previous to any purchase. In case of non-compliance with the specified dates, WAT reserves the decision to charge the total amount of the payment made.

Any expense already made by WAT that does not allow the cancellation of the reserved tour will not be refunded and will be assumed by the client independent of the 30% cancellation fee (example: train to Machu Picchu).

For reasons of force majeure on the client's part

Each purchased tour has a particular condition for cancellations due to events of force majeure which can be inquired previous to any purchase. In these cases, WAT will side with the client and will evaluate the charges for expenses individually per case. The client must prove the fortuitous event that prevents the completion of the tour.

For reasons of force majeure on WAT's part

Due to the responsibility of the providers: In their quality as intermediary, WAT will not respond for any cancellations decided by the providers as WAT does not have any legal representation or administrative control over them.

For external motives: WAT is not responsible for cancellations due to events of a climatic, social, or other nature that impede the completion of the tour.

However, in both cases mentioned in the lines above, WAT ensures assistance and help to the client at all times in order to guarantee their satisfaction.

REFUNDS

Refund for payments will only be made when they are within the established time frame in the conditions mentioned lines above. The client will choose the means of return and will assume any financial expense. Once the refund has been made, WAT will send the proof of payment via e-mail.

DURING THE TOUR

CANCELLATION OF THE TOUR DUE TO INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

WAT reserves the right to cancel the tour without the possibility of a refund when the passenger finds themselves unable to take the tour (example: under the influence of alcohol or drugs, hostile behavior, any other situation which might put the other passengers' security at risk, etc).

CANCELLATION OF THE TOUR DUE TO PERSONAL REASONS

If the client decides during the tour not to complete it for personal reasons (self-will, health reasons, physical injuries, etc) no refund will be considered. In that sense, WAT offers a 24 hours contact phone number to help clients during their tour. The same applies for any type of omission or breaking of the rules by the passenger.

CANCELLATION OF THE TOUR DUE TO EXTERNAL REASONS

In case a tour must be cancelled for reasons external to WAT (climate, social strikes, political events, etc), we reserve the right not to give a total refund in order to cover certain obligations assumed with providers in compliance to their sales conditions.

POSTPONEMENT OF THE TOUR DUE TO EXTERNAL REASONS

In case the tour must be postponed for reasons external to WAT (climate, social strikes, political events, etc), any additional expense for the completion of the service must be assumed by the client without WAT assuming any responsibility.

DEFECTS IN SERVICE DUE TO EXTERNAL REASONS

The quality of certain tours may suffer variations for reasons external to the operation of the tour and specific to the destination (example: water or power cuts, WiFi). In this case WAT does not assume any responsibilities and only informs that they are contingencies which may occur.

DELAYS

WAT does not assume any responsibility for delays during the tour and for any consequences these may generate for the client.

SECURITY

We recommend to our clients to take care of all their personal belongings. WAT is not responsible, for damages, losses, or theft during the tour.

REFUNDS FOR CLAIMS

REFUND REQUESTS

Any request for refunds must be made via e-mail in a period no longer than 15 days after the end of the tour and the client must provide detailed proof of the reasons for the claim. WAT will respond by the same means and will evaluate the request in a just and impartial manner. In case the refund proceeds, the reimbursement method will be coordinated with the client and any expenses or commissions that arise will be assumed.

WAT AS INTERMEDIARY

WAT acts as intermediary for the hiring of Touristic Services, those being hired with and operated by the selected Providers. In accordance to that, WAT is not obliged to, directly or indirectly, execute the Touristic Services and WAT's responsibility will be determined only under those conditions.

ACCEPTANCE OF RISKS AND EXONERATION OF RESPONSIBILITY

WAT, in their role as intermediary, is compromised only to offer services that guarantee the adequate security standards. However, there will always be risks that are specific to the Activity and transfers, for which the client assumes and renounces expressly and voluntarily certain legal rights for any personal damage, injury, or death that they might suffer during the tour. In accordance to that, the user excludes WAT from any responsibility linked to any accident or injury that might occur associated to their health, physical condition, clothing or equipment, or of any other kind.
