Discover more about the history of Lima, a city full of charm and tradition. Founded in 1535 by Francisco Pizarro, Lima was dubbed "The City of Kings" for its political and cultural significance during the Viceroyalty of Peru.

Explore the Historic Center of the city, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1991. Stroll through its streets adorned with beautiful churches, convents, and mansions that preserve the tradition of Hispano-American Baroque, offering a glimpse into the architectural and urban development of this ancient Spanish colonial city. Visit iconic sites such as the "Santo Domingo Convent," featuring its historic library, tranquil gardens, and the relics of three Peruvian saints.

Finally, visit the renowned Larco Museum, founded in 1926 by Rafael Larco Hoyle. The museum houses an extensive collection of pre-Columbian art, particularly known for its impressive collection of ceramics, textiles, and metallurgical objects, including gold and silver, from various ancient cultures of Peru, such as the Moche, Nazca, Chimú, and Inca.

- At the end of the tour, choose to stay at the Larcomar Shopping Center or return directly to your hotel.

- Lima is home to the largest Chinese community in Latin America and the second-largest Japanese community in the region. The presence of these cultures has led to fascinating cultural exchanges, with one of the most notable being the culinary fusion known as "chifa," which blends elements of Chinese cuisine with Peruvian flavors.
- Since its founding in 1926, the Larco Museum has been a pioneer in providing public access to its collections. It was one of the first museums in the world to have visitable storage rooms and to offer virtual access to 100% of its collection, thus promoting the multidisciplinary research that Rafael Larco Hoyle initiated from the beginning.
